

Cedar Point Rules

GENERAL RULES

We represent our school and community as we travel. Students are to be considerate of everyone with whom we come in contact.

Students are to use appropriate language and demonstrate good behavior.

The use or possession of tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs is absolutely prohibited for EVERYONE, including adults.

Students assume full responsibility for all valuables taken on the trip.

Students should wear comfortable school approved clothing. Students are to wear foot attire that is attached to the foot through laces or buckles. Sandals not attached to the foot, are not allowed. Please bring warm clothes incase the air conditioning is too cold, especially on the trip home, if you are still wet.

Please bring at least \$15.00-20.00 for food. The cost of food is expensive and the park prohibits outside food or drink in the park. The park officials can and do search purses or backpacks entering the park.

BUS RULES

Students are to remain seated while the bus is in motion.

Providing the student follows bus rules, students may switch seats after we are underway and their chaperone has given permission.

Students may take food and soft drinks on the bus (no glass containers or cans). Please keep the bus clean and dispose of all trash properly. Small coolers are appropriate if you wish.

Radios, CD, MP3 players "game boys" may be played with headphones on the bus. Personal DVD players are not allowed. The bus will be locked while we are in the park.

You may bring DVD's and VCR "G" and "PG" rated videos to watch during the bus ride. I am not sure if the bus will be equipped with the DVD player or the VCR Player or both, but it will have at least one of them.

CEDAR POINT

Each student is to stay with his/her designated group until they are released at Public Safety. We will walk there together as a group. The chaperones will point out exactly where to meet at the 2:00 PM check in. When the chaperones release them, the students are free to wander on their own.

Students are required to always be with a same sex partner and never travel **ANYPLACE** alone.

No student may "ditch" his or her partner. If they wish to trade partners it must be mutual, or you must see a chaperone to settle any problems. For no reason, should anyone ever be alone. Failure to follow this rule will result in all students involved being punished. If everyone watches out for everyone else, we will not have any students "stuck" with Mrs. Armstrong for the remainder of the day.

Students must not leave Cedar Point Park for any reason. No Water Park, no Bungee jumping rides. (There is a separate charge and we did NOT pay for this portion of the park)

At the 2:00PM check in, **chaperones should check in with Mrs. Armstrong before checking in the students** for any changes to our schedule. Please, chaperones, be very specific as to where and what time to meet your students. Keeping in mind, the buses are departing at 6:30 PM sharp from the parking lot. Any students late or not checking in, I need to be made aware of. Any student not checking in or checking in late will be punished as well as their future ability to travel with us will be in jeopardy.

RETURN TRIP

Meet your chaperone at the designated time and place and walk to the buses together. **Please know your Bus number!**

We will depart for home at 6:30 PM sharp. There is NO excuse to be late.

We should be at Fort Gratiot Middle School at 10:00pm and **students will NOT be allowed to enter the building to call home.** Please have your ride at Fort Gratiot at 10:00 PM. Mrs. Armstrong will be very tired and wants to go home.
