

7th & 8th Grade Band Student's Cedar Point Trip

Wednesday June 16, 2010

6:15 a.m.	Arrive at Fort Gratiot
6:30 a.m.	Depart Fort Gratiot Middle School
10:00 a.m.	Arrive at Cedar Point and we will not enter the park early.
10:00 a.m.	Park opens (stay with your group until we get to public safety where we will check in at 2:00)
2:00 p.m.	Check-in at Public Safety (Police Dept.)
6:30 p.m.	Depart for home
10:00 p.m.	Arrive at Fort Gratiot. (Students will NOT be entering the building)

Due to the size and nature of Cedar Point, the students will **NOT** be under direct supervision while in the park. However, they must always be with at least one, same sex partner. Nobody EVER goes anywhere alone, or they will be stuck with Mrs. Armstrong, and she does not do rides, it will not be fun.

Dress code is school-approved clothing with the addition of footwear that attaches to the foot through buckles, straps, or laces. Flip-flops are not appropriate. Swimwear is NOT appropriate. Tank tops with spaghetti straps are not appropriate.

The buses will be locked. You may leave personal belongings on the bus. Food and drink is fine on the bus, just try to be considerate of others. Put garbage in the trash bag and not on the floor. Bring "G" rated videos if you want entertainment. I am not sure if they are equipped with VCR's or DVD's. Bring both. .

No hot beverages allowed on the bus for students.

No bottles or cans of liquid allowed on the bus. (Please bring plastic bottles with a screw top)

The park does NOT allow food or drink to be brought inside the park; they may search backpacks and purses. Food and drink is expensive.

Please have a watch so you will not be late for check in or return check in. There is no excuse to be late and if you are not 5 minutes early, you are late! There will be **severe** consequences for any late students.

Please bring at least \$15.00 for food and even more money, if you wish to spend it at the arcade. It is a good idea to bring some form of sun protection, there is very little shade at the park.

Remember the rules and treat our parents really well so they will volunteer again. We need them!
